INTERESSANT I DETTE NYHEDSBREV

- Værdien af doneret medicin og hospitalsudstyr overstiger nu 128 mio kr / The value of donated medicine and equipment reaches more than DKK 128 million.

REORGANISERING!

Kære Alle!

Samarbejdet med private firmaer, organisationer og hospitaler udvides og styrkes fortsat, en stor donation af værdifulde maskiner åbner interessante perspektiver (projektopgaver).

Økonomien stabiliseres, registrering af lagerbeholdningen/donationerne er næsten tilendebragt, ny hjemmeside tages meget snart i brug, forholdet til vore samarbejdspartnere forstærkes, donationerne til Ukraines Sundhedsministerium er ophørt, fortsat problemer med donationerne i 2014 til Kenya og Senegal.

Kommunikationen til/fra medlemmerne vil blive forsøgt styrket, ny organisation måske udarbejdet, økonomien forbedret, både ved øgede indtægter og besparelser, og øgede medicindonationer vil blive søgt.

Doneret medicin for 2.559.520 kr. og hospitalsudstyr for 2.359.000 kr. til kun et enkelt land, Ukraine, bortset fra en professionel hjertestarter til Kobane, Syrien.

I alt doneret for 128.655.357 kr. medicin og hospitalsudstyr siden stiftelsen 2010.

MEDICIN OG UDSTYR:

Ukraine: Al medicin og næsten alt udstyr er doneret til Ukraines Forsvarsministerium, Lægelig Departement, desuden udstyr til hospitaler og en ubrugt, professionel hjertestarter til den kurdiske by, Kobane, **Syrien**.

Senegal: Indholdet af de to containere vil blive søgt fordelt og sagen dermed afsluttet i januar 2016.

Kenya: Container stadig liggende i havnen.

Fremover vil ikke kun fragtudgifter, men også modtagerens havneudgifter blive krævet indbetalt før afsendelse af donation.

ØKONOMI:

Økonomien er styrket, rejseudgifter, fragt- og lageromkostninger reduceret, men fortsat behov for forbedringer, især i betragtning af forventede øgede udgifter til klargøring af hospitalsudstyr, og til projektopgaver.

VÆSENTLIGE BEGIVENHEDER:

Samarbejdet med **private firmaer, organisationer og hospitaler** styrkes og udvides, dog fortsat ingen fremgang med medicin donationer, utvivlsomt grundet manglende henvendelser til medicinalfirmaer, hvilket der vil blive rettet op på.

Medicinalvirksomheden Vingmed A/S har ydet en økonomisk og sundhedsmæssig væsentlig donation, bestående af et meget stort antal maskiner, kun brugt i tre år, der fraktionerer (opdel) blod i tre forskellige komponenter. Maskinerne vil have meget stor betydning for ethvert udviklingsland, men der kræves udgifter til klargøring og reservedele samt kontrol med modtagerlandets anvendelse af maskinerne.

Et samarbejde med en virksomhed, der yder en væsentlig donation bestående af maskiner til GMA, hvor modtagerlandets sundhedsministerium efterfølgende er ansvarlig, også i økonomisk henseende, med GMA som formidler og kontrolinstans, er interessant for alle tre parter og åbner vide perspektiver, og mulighed for egentlige projektopgaver.

Et sådant samarbejde blev forsøgt med Ukraines Sundhedsministerium, der var meget interesseret i maskinerne, som der er et stort behov for, men da ministeriet ikke kunne indestå for bl.a. de nødvendige blodposer og vedligeholdelsen, måtte samarbejdet, i enhver henseende, afbrydes.

Maskinerne er nu tilbudt Sri Lanka, der har accepteret disse.

Samarbejdet med Order of Malta, Ukraine er blevet styrket, Ordenens ambassadør har i et interview med Forbes Magazine udtalt, at GMA er en af Ordenens vigtigste internationale partnere og samarbejdet med Ordenen forventes fortsat, evt. via en til Ordenen knyttet organisation.

Samarbejdet med Falck er fortsat, GMA har formidlet salg af tre ambulancer til Ukraine, ambulancerne blev fyldt med udstyr fra GMA.

Lagerbeholdningen er blevet registreret, således at ind- og udgående effekter fremover vil blive registreret, Toyota har solgt en selvkørende palleløfter på fordelagtige vilkår til GMA.

Det overvejes, hvorledes medlemmerne mere aktivt kan medvirke til løsning af foreningens øgede aktiviteter, en reorganisering synes uundgåelig.

500 m3 hospital equipment, valued at DKK 5.668.000 —as well as medicine for DKK466.560 donated to one country, Ukraine.

REORGANIZATION!

Dear all!

The cooperation with private companies, organizations and hospitals has been expanded and is still being strengthened. A large donation of valuable machines opens interesting perspectives (project assignments).

The finances have been stabilized, registration of inventory/donations is nearly at an end, and a new website is close to being online. The relationship to our cooperative partners is strengthening, donations to the Health Ministry of Ukraine has ceased, and there are continuing problems in 2014 with donations to Kenya and Senegal.

Communication to/from members will be sought strengthened, and new organization perhaps developed. Finances improved, via a combination of increased intake and cut-backs, and increased medicine donations will be sought.

Medicine valued at DKK2,559,520 and hospital equipment for DKK2,359,000 donated to one single country, Ukraine, apart from a professional defibrillator to Kobane, Syria.

Total value of medicine and medical equipment donated since the start in 2010 now reaches DKK128,655,357.

MEDICINE AND EQUIPMENT:

Ukraine:

All medicine and nearly all equipment have been donated to the Ukrainian Ministry of Defense, Medical Department and equipment to hospitals. An unused professional defibrillator donated to the Kurdish city, Kobane, **Syria**.

Kenya: Containers still situated in the harbor.

Senegal: The contents of the two containers will be distributed, and the case ended in January 2016.

FINANCES:

The finances have been strengthened, travel, freight and storage costs reduced, but there is a continuous need for improvement, especially considering the expected increase in funds to prepare hospital equipment, and for project assignments.

NOTEWORTHY EVENTS:

The cooperation with **private companies, organizations and hospitals** is strengthening and expanding. However, there have been no progress in medicine donations, which no doubt has to do with lack of communication to the medicinal companies, something that will be rectified.

The medical company Vingmed A/S has provided a financial and health wise substantial donation that includes a very large number of machines, only used for three years, that fractions (divides) blood into three different components. The machines will have a large impact for any developing country, but there are costs associated with preparation and spare parts in addition to control of the recipient country's use of the machines.

Cooperation between a company who provides a substantial donation to GMA of machines, and the local Ministry of Health is very interesting for all three parts and open wide perspectives, and the possibility for project assignments.

The recipient country's Ministry of Health is responsible, also in a financial respect, with GMA as a facilitator and controlling entity.

Such a joint project was sought with Ukraine's Ministry of Health who was very interested in the machines that are sorely needed. However, since the Ministry could not give guarantees, f.eks for the necessary blood bags and the maintenance, the joint project had to be ended in all respects.

The machines have since been offered to Sri Lanka who have accepted these.

The cooperation with the Order of Malta, Ukraine has been strengthened, the ambassador of the Order has, in an interview with Forbes Magazine, mentioned that GMA is one of the order's most important international partners, and the cooperation with the order is expected to continue, possibly via an organization linked to the order.

The cooperation with Falck has continued. GMA has mediated the sale of three ambulances to the Ukraine and the ambulances were filled with equipment from GMA.

The inventory has been registered so that incoming and outgoing effects in the future will be registered. Toyota has sold a self-propelled pallet lifter on advantageous terms to GMA.
