Yderligere fremgang!

Andet halvår 2011 udviklede sig yderst tilfredsstillende for GMA - især vedrørende mængden af doneret medicin, men i øvrigt i enhver henseende.

Medicin: Værdien af doneret medicin androg ca 23 mio kr, heraf ca 20 mio kr fra en enkelt donation - siden stiftelsen marts 2010 har vi doneret medicin for over 45 mio kr. Vi donerer fortsat kun til Afghanistan, Burkina Faso, Nepal og Sri Lanka – Somaliland afventer

Afghanistan:

Vi har genoptaget kontakten med dr. Shah – Philips repræsentant i Afghanistan – og forsøger at etablere en filial i Kabul, der skal danne grundlag for donation af medicin og udstyr

Nepal:

Samarbejdet med Neel Tamrakar forløber godt, vi forventer at udvide donationerne til hele Nepal



Burkina Faso:

To 40 fods containere med medicin og udstyr er netop ankommet.

Sri Lanka: Aftalen med regeringen er nu underskrevet – regeringen vil sørge for klarering og distribution til destinationer efter aftale med os – vi har indledt samarbejde med Priya Dissanayake og forventer at donere betydelige mængder medicin og udstyr.

Aftalen med regeringen er i sig selv meget værdifuld, idet den øger mulighederne for at få yderligere medicin og udstyr, og den kan tillige danne grundlag for tilsvarende aftale med andre lande.

Medicinalfirmaer:

Yderligere fem medicinalfirmaer støtter os—vi samarbejder nu med 15 medicinalfirmaer.

Medicinsk udstyr:

Vi har doneret en del udstyr fra Frederiksberg og Hvidovre Hospitaler til Burkina Faso og en 40 fods container med inventar fra Sct. Hans Hospital til Sri Lanka – vi forventer at kunne donere yderligere 3 - 4 40 fods containere med senge og inventar.

Det undersøges fortsat, bl.a. ved hjælp af Region Hovedstaden, hvor meget udstyr regionens hos-

pitaler kan stille til vor rådighed.

Økonomi: Vi har modtaget 250.000 kr. i de sidste seks måneder, i alt 400.000 kr i år – økonomien er pt. nogenlunde god, selvom der har været afholdt rejseudgifter til Sri Lanka og Burkina Faso og selvom vi har måttet afholde en del udgifter i forbindelse med levering af udstyr og inventar.

Der må forventes øgede udgifter i forbindelse med levering af udstyr og rejser til lande, vi fremover agter at samarbejde med.

Store mængder udstyr doneret i det sidste halve år

Praktikanter: Carina Rosenfeldt Pedersen stopper som praktikant på fuld tid i GMA. Hun vil stadigvæk være tilknyttet GMA, men som freelance.

Der er tilknyttet to nye praktikanter som skal arbejde 10 timer pr. uge.

Camilla E. Callesen studerer Internationale studier og engelsk på Aalborg Universitet. Hun har tidligere arbejdet for Ungdommens Røde Kors.

Dan Pham studerer BA Negot ved Syddansk Universitet i Odense.

For begge gælder det, at det er en ulønnet praktikplads, som varer indtil 30. april 2012.

Global Medical Aid vil nu konsolidere sig og forbedre samarbejdet med medicinalfirmaer, udenlandske samarbejdspartnere etc., og samtidig vil vi forsøge at øge vore aktiviteter i enhver henseende.

Der er derfor fortsat brug for hjælp fra medlemmernes side til at skaffe gratis medicin og udstyr til fattige patienter i den tredje verden.

GMA through the past 6 months

Further successes!

The second part of 2011 developed most satisfactorily for GMA – especially regarding the quantity of donated medicine, but also in every other regard.

Medicine: The value of donated medicine has come to DKK 23 million, whereof DKK 20 million was from a single donation. Since the foundation in March 2010 we have now donated for more than DKK 45 million. We are currently still only donating to Afghanistan, Burkina Faso, Nepal, and Sri Lanka – Somaliland is still on hold.

Afghanistan

We have resumed contact with Dr. Shah, the representative from Phillips in Afghanistan, and are trying to establish a branch office in Kabul which is supposed to be the basis for donations of medicine and equipment.

Sri Lanka: The agreement with the government is now signed. The government will take care of handling and distribution after agreement with us. We have started cooperation with Priya Disanayake and expect to donate substantial amounts of medicine and equipment.

The agreement with the government in itself is very valuable

since it increases the possibilities to get additional medicine and equipment. It can also act as the foundation for similar agreements with other countries.

Nepal: The cooperation with Neel Tamrakar is proceeding well. We are expecting to expand our donations to all of Nepal.

Burkina Faso: Two 40 foot containers with medicine and equipment have just arrived in Burkina Faso.

Medicinal companies:

An additional five medical companies support us – We now cooperate with 15 medicinal companies.

Donation of medicine and equipment now over DKK 45 million

Medical equipment: We have donated a lot of equipment from Frederiksberg and Hvidovre Hospitals to Burkina Faso, and a 40 foot container with inventory from Sct. Hans Hospital to Sri Lanka. We expect to donate a further 3 to 4 40 foot containers with beds and inventory from Sct. Hans Hospital.

It is continuously being investigated, by amongst others Region Hovedstaden, how much equipment can be provided from the region's hospitals to us.

Finances: We have received DKK 250.000 in the past six months with a total of DKK 400.000 for the year. The economy is fairly sound even though there have been some travel expenses to Sri Lanka and Burkina Faso, and even though we have had some additional expenses regarding delivery of equipment and inventory. It is expected that expenses will increase for delivery of equipment and to countries we are expecting to work with.

Interns: Carina Rosenfeldt Pedersen has ended her time as the full-time intern at GMA. She will now be a part of GMA in a freelance position. There have, however, been hired two interns who will work 10 hours per week.

Camilla E. Callesen studies International Studies and English at Aalborg University. She has previously worked for the Youth division of the Danish Red Cross.

Dan Pham is studying BA Negot at Syddansk University in Odense.

They are both hired in a non-paid internship which will last until April 30, 2012.
